The Honourable Acting Justice Jane Mathews AO



The Honourable Acting Justice Jane Mathews spent seventeen years in private practice before being appointed a judge of the District Court in 1980, the first woman judge in NSW. In 1987 she was appointed to the Supreme Court of NSW, the first woman judge on that court. In 1994, she became a judge of the Federal Court of Australia and was also President of the Administrative Appeals Tribunal and Deputy President of the National Native Titles Tribunal. In 2001 she retired from the Federal Court and became an Acting Judge on the NSW Supreme Court, a position which she still holds.

Justice Mathews also holds honorary LID degrees from Sydney and Wollongong Universities. Justice Mathews has served on The Women's College Council since 2002 and is the Patron of the Women Lawyers' Association of NSW.

The Honourable Justice Julie Ward



The Honourable Justice Julie Ward was admitted as a solicitor of the Supreme Court of New South Wales in 1982 and in 1988, at the age of 28, became the youngest female partner at Mallesons Stephen Jaques. Justice Ward held a number of roles in her twenty years as a partner and acquired extensive experience in commercial litigation and alternative dispute resolution, acting in matters in a number of States and in the Federal jurisdiction.

In 2008, Justice Ward was the first woman solicitor to be appointed directly to the Supreme Court of NSW. She sits in the Equity Division. Justice Ward has been a Director of Pricewaterhouse Coopers Charitable Foundation and is a member of the NSW Women Lawyers' Association.
