

The Women's College within The University of Sydney is a globally connected, secular residential community of female scholars—the first to be established in Australia in 1892. We offer unrivalled opportunities for enhanced academic, cultural, sporting, leadership and professional development for our students: known as The Women's College Advantage.

The Women's College Advantage encompasses bespoke leadership and mentoring programs; small academic tutorials led by our Teaching Fellows; an established Scholars' Program; access to corporate internships and a diverse global alumnae network that is dynamic and actively involved with the College community.

In addition to residential places, we offer a unique Affiliate Student Program to enable students to access the benefits of The Women's College Advantage, but maintain independent living elsewhere. Affiliate applications are accepted throughout the year from women at all stages of their tertiary studies.

Scholarships opportunities are available for undergraduate and postgraduate students of merit. Most scholarships also have a requirement of financial need. Specific scholarships for girls from government schools, music performance students, The University of Sydney elite athletes, E12, medical, indigenous students and affiliate students are available.

College Life

The Women's College participates in the Palladian Cup, an Intercollegiate cultural competition offering students opportunities to be involved. The competition includes solo and ensemble categories across art, music, drama, debating, public speaking, dance and instrumental options.

Many opportunities to further contribute to the cultural programs are available within The Women's College calendar, particularly at the College's Formal Dinners.

The Intercollegiate women's sporting competition is a fun and fiercely contested part of the calendar. Each year Women's competes in eight sports for the Macrae Archdale Cup, affectionately known as the Rosebowl. The swimming, hockey, netball and rowing competitions are in first semester, and basketball, soccer, athletics and tennis take place in second semester.
